“OF WHOM THE WORLD WAS NOT WORTHY” — HEBREWS 11:32-40

At the climax of this great chapter, the writer magnifies those who have persevered through faith with the words, “Of whom the world was not worthy.” Who are these faithful believers, and how do they encourage our own faith in God’s promises?

1. Some who, through faith, were “made strong out of weakness” (vv. 30–35a).
2. Others who, through faith, persevered until a terrible end (vv. 35b–38).
3. All who, despite faith, did not receive what was promised (vv. 39–40).
