Q. Who created you, the world, and everything in the world?

A. The almighty God *alone* created me, the world, and everything in the world. **Isaiah 45:18-** For thus says the LORD, who created the heavens (he is God!), who formed the earth and made it (he established it; he did not create it empty, he formed it to be inhabited!): "I am the LORD, and there is no other." (502)
