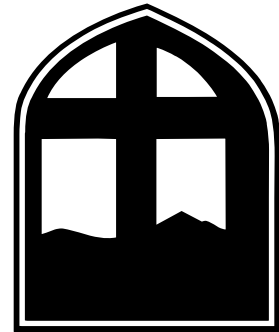

THE TRANSFORMING TOUCH from MARK 5:25-34

Pastor George Stiekas

Jesus said, "Come unto Me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest" (Matt 11:28). Many people try everything else before coming to Jesus. The woman who was plagued with hemorrhaging for twelve years lived a wretched life. She had heard reports of Jesus' power to heal and felt she had nothing to lose.

In Mark 5:1-20 – Jesus went to the demon possessed man in Gadara. Jairus proved that Jesus was approachable and came to Christ for help. He learned that Jesus will even go with us. He loves and cares for us and is always waiting for us to come to Him.

Tradition names the woman in our text either Bernice or Veronica, a native of Caesarea Philippi. Like the demoniac and the daughter of Jairus, her circumstances are hopeless, but she realized the word hopeless does not exist in the mind of Jesus Christ.
