Jesus' Ministry to His Servants – 2 Timothy 4:16-18

In his final testimony, Paul recounts what the Lord Jesus did and is doing for him because he is His servant. His words are a tremendous encouragement to us as believers who would faithfully render service to Christ, for they teach us that Jesus ministers to His servants in at least *two assuring ways*:

- 1. Jesus strengthens His servants (16-17a).
 - a. He strengthens us by standing near even if others forsake.

...no one stood with me... but the Lord stood with me.

- b. He strengthens us as we minister for His sake.
 - (1) We are the *channels* of His ministry. ...so that the message might be preached...through me.
 - (2) Others are the *objects* of His ministry. ...so that ...all the Gentiles might hear.
- 2. Jesus delivers His servants (17b-18).
 - a. He delivers us with respect to this age.
 - (1) He rescues us from death. *I was delivered out of the mouth of the lion.*
 - (2) He rescues us from the attacks of the enemy. *The Lord will deliver me from every evil work...*
 - b. He delivers us with respect to the age to come. *The Lord...will preserve me for His heavenly kingdom.*
