Philosophy is a means by which we discern the truth about the unseen. As believers in Christ, we must take care to guard our thinking against bad philosophy. In this text, Paul warns us not to be taken captive by a philosophy which is marked by four terrible qualities:

1.	It is groundless at its baseempty deceit
2.	It is human in its originaccording to the tradition of men
3.	It is worldly in its understandingaccording to the basic principles of the world
4.	It is Christless in its content not according to Christ.
