God's Final Word (Part 2) – Hebrews 1:1-3 Greg Stiekes, Pastor

God the Father has spoken to His people in many ways. But the *final word* concerning all that God is doing in salvation history is embodied in the Son, for He is the focus and fulfillment of all God has promised. The opening verses of Hebrews shows that Christ Jesus is God's final word for three reasons:

- 1. Jesus is the final word because of His *essence* (1:3). who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person
- 2. Jesus is the final word because of His works (1:2, 3).
 through whom also He made the worlds . . .
 and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins
- 3. Jesus is the final word because of His *status* (1:2, 3). *whom He has appointed heir of all things* . . . *sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high*
